- The Science Curriculum Team Professional Development and Curriculum Alignment Proposal was presented to the district administration

- Mathematics Summer Institute for elementary and middle school teachers took place August 1 and 2, 2006 at Central High School
- **CR**reating **I**ndependence through **S**tudent Owned **S**trategies (CRISS) at the middle school level took place August 21, 22, 24, 25, 28 and 29, 2006 at the NEA office in Manchester
- DI professional development chairperson attended the NHDOE training on the new Master Plan requirements from the State Board of Education
- Two mathematics coaches for the elementary schools, one mathematics coach for the middle schools and one language arts implementation specialist were hired to work with the teachers in the district on the implementation of the newly aligned mathematics and language arts curriculums
- One language arts coach position for the middle schools is currently posted and looking to be filled
