Development and Evaluation of Curriculum

- The Science Curriculum Core Team was formed and met on June 9, 2006
- Members of the Science Curriculum Core Team attended the Science Summer Institute on July 17-21 at Southern New Hampshire University. They met to create a curriculum alignment and implementation plan and begin writing the new Science Curriculum
- Secondary Language Arts Curriculum was approved by the Curriculum and Instruction subcommittee in June and the BOSC in July
- Assessment for Learning book study continues over the summer with the DI Assessment Team
- Understanding by Design book study continues over the summer with the DI Curriculum Team

- The Curriculum and Instruction subcommittee approved the professional development plan created by the Professional Development Team for the early release and workshop days
